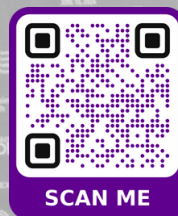

### PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

The proposal must seek funding with the objective to establish, support, or enhance fatherhood programming in Kentucky:

1

Events that elevate or celebrate father involvement

2

Programs that connect fathers to needed community resources

3

Public education campaigns that promote father involvement

4

Projects that reduce child maltreatment through father involvement

### ELIGIBILITY

- Kentucky-based organization or individual
- Nonprofits/501 (c)3 and faith-based organizations
- Agencies acting as fiscal sponsor for an individual or community collaborative



## GRANT TIERS

### TIER 1 UP TO \$5,000

Proposals for a **one-time activity or program**. Events in June highlighting Fathers in conjunction with Father's Day are encouraged. **Funding up to \$5,000.**

### TIER 2 UP TO \$10,000

Proposals that (1) host at least one event (**recruitment, information fair, Father's Day event, etc.**), and (2) deliver an **evidenced-based curriculum and/or a battery of services to a group of fathers**. **Funding up to \$10,000.**
