



# DADDY DATA

- 1. Father engagement reduces the frequency of behavioral problems in boys while also decreasing delinquency and economic disadvantage in low-income families.
- 2. People with actively involved father figures during childhood are more likely to have an improved ability to handle stress.
- 3. Children whose fathers are involved in their daily care such as feeding, bathing and playing together, tend to be more confident; and, as they grow older, enjoy stronger social connections with peers.
