- Inform advocacy work that will address responsible fatherhood

Request for Proposals

Grant Tiers

Tier 1 UP TO \$5,000

Proposals for a one-time activity or program. Events in June highlighting Fathers in conjunction with Father's Day are encouraged. Funding **up to \$5,000.**

Tier 2 UP TO \$10,000

Proposals that (1) host at least one event (recruitment, information fair, Father's Day event, etc.), and (2) deliver an evidenced-based curriculum and/or a battery of services to a group of fathers. Funding **up to \$10,000.**
